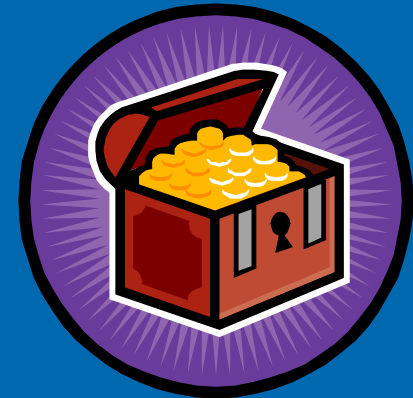

- Expect completion by end of month.

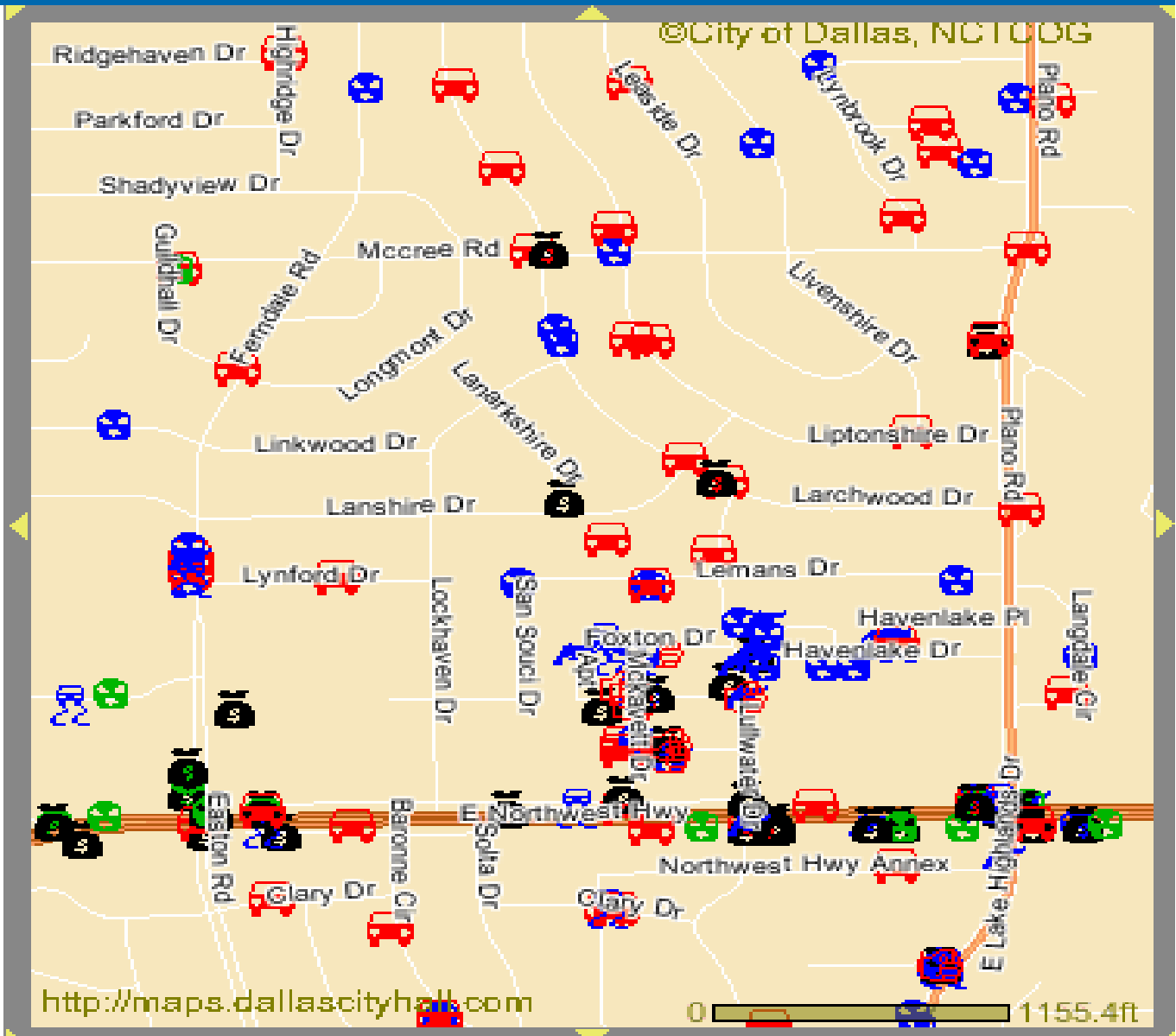
Crime Watch

- Thefts from front or back yards.



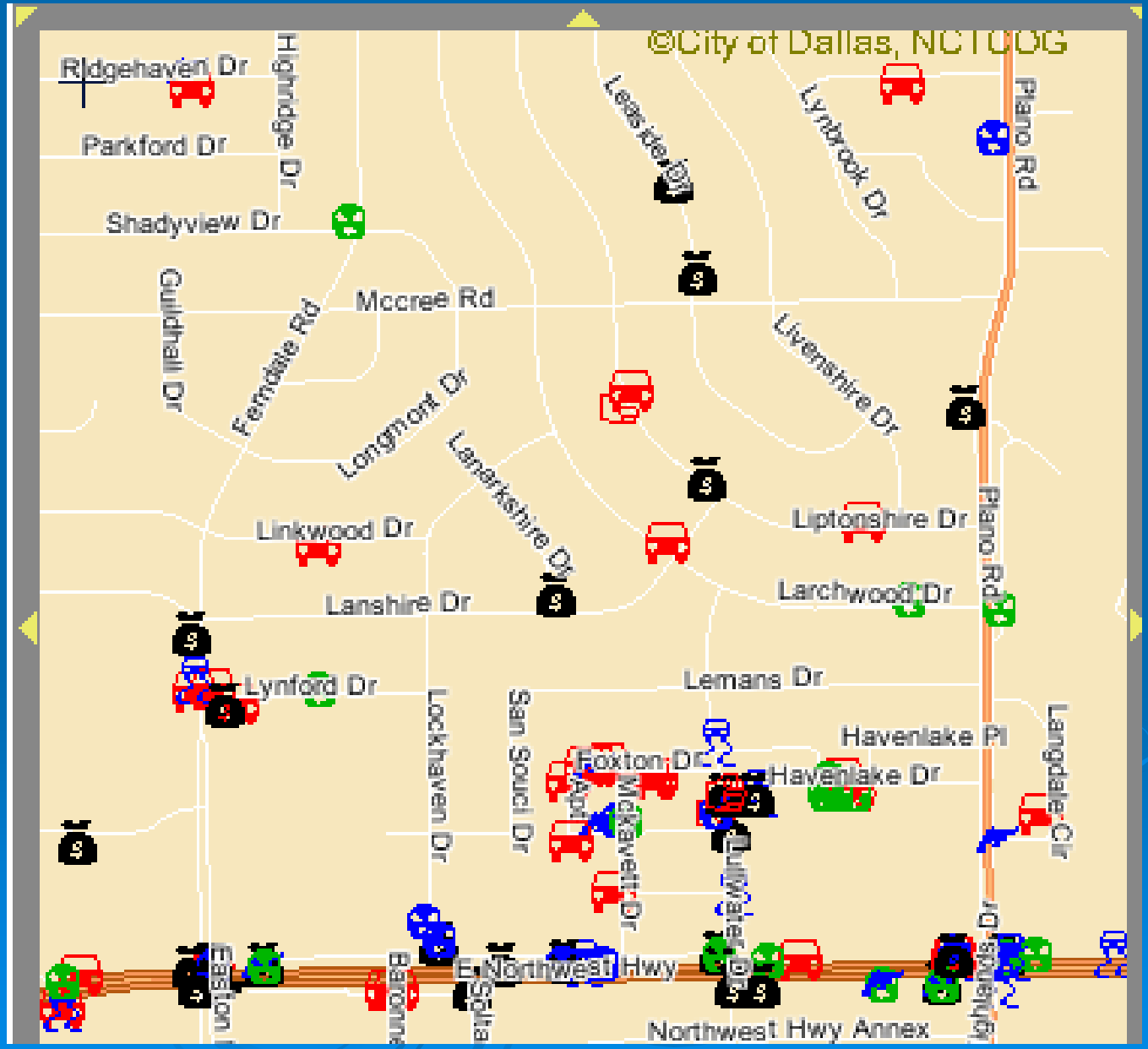
